Playing again in the G League – this season for the Osceola Magic – the 6-foot-2 McChung returns to All-Star Weekend in Indianapolis to play in the Rising Stars event. "There was a funny loke or a meme – a 25-year-old rising joke or a meme - a 25-year-old rising star," he said. "But there's something beautiful about it, too.

McClung will also defend his slam dunk title against Boston's Jaylen Brown, New York/G League Westches-ter Knicks' Jacob Toppin and Miami's Jaime Jaquez Jr.

At Gate City High in southwest Vir-At Gate City High in southwest Vir-ginia – small, mountain-town Appala-chia – McClung became a viral sensa-tion with his dunks and skills. For a brief time, McChung was Virginia's all-time leading scorer in boys basketball and scored 47 in a state title game in 2018. He attracted the attention of major Division I colleges and spent two seasons at Georgetown and one at Texas Tech,

then declared for the draft in 2021.

He was not drafted and has spent the past three years trying to get a guaranteed NBA contract. He was the G League Rookie of the Year in 2021-22 and has proved himself as a scorer (21.3 career average) and playmaker (6.4 career assists per game).

to add intrigue and spice to the dunk contest last season, the NBA invited

McClung, who had at the time played in just two NBA games. With All-Stars cheering him on courtside, he won with a series of dunks jumping over people and 360 and 540 aerials – he clinched the victory with his third perfect 50 score from the judges while wearing his GEACK!! With his room.

score from the judges while wearing his Gate City High jersey.

"He solidified himself as probably one of the greatest slam dunk competitors that we've had in the history of the game," said Los Angeles Lakers star Le-Bron James, who added he had been watching McClung's videos since McClung's high school days.

Dominique Wilkins was a judge and

Dominique Wilkins was a judge, and Julius Erving - two of the best dunkers

ever - presented McChing with the tro ever - presented McClung with the tro-phy. Family and friends were in atten-dance, and his press conference that night was filled with joy. "Everyone around me, I love them and they love me," he said. "I just felt

really lucky. And I think that's the key to never forget how lucky we are to do what we do and to have the experiences. Fve had. I felt that and I still feel that to this day. That was the coolest part – just my family and best friends being there."

The dunk contest opened previously unavailable doors. McClung won-stoo,000 for his dunk contest, he signed deals with Puma, AT&T and Raising Cane's and he has a short film

coming out this summer (nothing to do with basketball).

with basketbell).

"You get to be in different rooms,"
McClung said. "I'm making sure I'm doing exactly what I want to do in life and
to not really limit myself to one thing."
His G League contract totals
\$120,000, and his Puma deal is valuable

enough that he turned down a seven-

enough that he turned down a seven-figure offer to play in China.

He has worked on his game – cutting down on floaters he attempted and try-ing to slow down his pace, moving with-out the basketball, setting better screens and applying more defensive Pressure. This sesson has programe. screens and applying more defensive pressure. This season, he averages 24.5 points, 6.7 assists, 4.6 rebounds and 1.0 steals and shoots 48.4% from the field and 37.1% on 3s.

Theard alot of GMs say, I don't know what he has to do. He's done a lot. But I keep applying pressure, "McClumg said.

March will be all about women's hoops



One tournament is going to feature the NCAA's all-time leading scorer who shoots deep step-back jumpers like Steph Curry. The other tournament's main character will be a 7-foot-4 center who has made one 3-pointer in his en-

who has made one s-pointer in its eitric career.

One tournament is going to test whether this decade's dominant program can become a dynasty. The other is going to be a roulette wheel of flawed and undependable teams.

One tournament is going to have an abundance of attitude, social media reseronalities antitude, social media reseronalities and sideline fashion. The

personalities and sideline fashion. The other will require a cheat sheet to identi-fy most of the relevant players and

coaches.

On Thursday, Iowa's Caitlin Clark made official what has long been fait accompli: She's the greatest, most creative, most exciting and most profile bucket-getter the women's college game has quar east.

And with March fast approaching, her milestone underscored what also should have been obvious for a while. This year, the women's NCAA basketball tournament is going to turn the Mad-ness on its head.

Three years ago, the NCAA took a boatload of criticism – much of it well-deserved – for treating the women's tournament as an afterthought.

Now? The men might as well get used

to being the opening act.
Thanks to Clark and South Carolina Thanks to Clark and South Carolina, Kim Mulkey and JuJu Watkins, Angel Reese and Paige Bucckers, the star pow-er and drama this March is decidedly on one end of the gender divide. Few events in sports can eclipse the spectacle of a men's Final Four. This

year, it's almost certainly going to hap-pen on the very same weekend.

Put your misogyny aside and just look at these two tournaments side-by-

What's a more compelling story: Can Dawn Staley lead South Carolina to an unbeaten season, or can Purdue finally beat a No. 15 or No. 16 seed?

What's a bigger draw: Watching Clark

fill it up from anywhere on the court, or Zach Edey parking himself in front of the rim and seeing how many times he gets fouled?

What's more made-for-TV: The garish Mulkey and her reality show of a basketball team trying to go back-to-back, or Dan Hurley and UConn suffocating opponents just like they did last year?

year?

Look, the men's tournament is going to be great. It always is. There will be upsets and dramatic finishes and new stars who emerge, like that little point guard from Kansas State last year. What's his name again? Admit'it: Itook you a second and maybe a Google search to come up with Markquis Nowell.

But the beauty of March is that there will be another Nowell type this year and the year after. Especially in this era, when college basketball's regular season appeals to a relatively small number of die-hards compared to what it used to be. The fun is in watching and discovering these teams when put under a totally different kind of pressure. We learn as we go, and it all feels a little bit random. The college basketball experts will tell you they knew how good Florida Atlantic was last season, but let's be real: When the tournament began, most people who care about college But the beauty of March is that there

gan, most people who care about college

sports couldn't have identified a single player on the roster or named the coach. Suddenly you look up, and it's playing in a Final Four.

a Final Four.

That's great theater, and men's college basketball really needs it. These days, the most-talented players are either playing in college for one year or not at all. Many who stay in college end up changing teams once, even twice. The superstrace once, even twice. superstar coaches who spent decades superstar coaches who spent decades dominating the tournament, like Mike Krzyzewski, Roy Williams, Jim Boeheim and Jay Wright, have either headed to retirement or, in the case of John Cali-pari and Tom 1220, aren't the forces of

This Year, though, the women's four-nament is serving up storylines on a sli-ver platter. The friction, the controversy, the dynamism – it's so one-sided, CBS executives have to be a little bit jealous that their billion-dollar investment into NCAA basketball doesn't even get the biggest stars of March on their airwaves. Instead: ESN and ABC will benethe

Instead, ESPN and ABC will have the privilege of showing the country whether Clark can drag Iowa back to the cham-pionship game. And unlike last year, when it felt as if people were just learn-ing about her or watching her for the first time, now she has a fan base – and haters, including former stars like She-ryl Swoopes. Whatever she does in the tournament, good or bad, is going to be talked about and covered this time like LeBron James trying to win his first title

But that's not all.

Dawn Staley, one of the most cele-Dawn Statey, one of the most cele-brated players and personalities in the history of women's basketball, already has two titles at South Carolina. She looked like a near-lock to get No. 3 last year until Clark's 41 points over-whelmed the Gamecocks in the semifiwneimed the Gamecocks in the semifi-nals. Now, South Carolina is again on the unbeaten track at 24-0 and blowing out pretty much everyone. Can it finish the job this time? Besides Clark, the women's tourna-

Besides Clark, the women's tourna-ment is going to have another virtueso performer in Watkins, who might be having the best freshman season in the history of the sport for Southern Cal at nearly 28 points per game. UConn may have slipped just a bit – Geno Auriemma is title-less since 2016– but there's still a familiarity to seeing the Huskies in big games and a sense of

the Huskies in big games and a sense of real conflict with historic implications

reat conflict with historic implications when they play the other superpowers. And then there's LSU, which on paper should have been a better team this year than last, when the Tigers won a surprise title in Mulkey's second sea-

Instead, LSU has had a weird year Instead, LSU has had a weird year with Reese missing four games early in the season for unspecified off-court reasons, and a few surprising losses that have raised questions about whether this team came back with the right focus this team came back with the right focus and intensity. Love her or hate het, though, Mulkey usually has het team ready to play in March – and will give us all plenty of sound bites and over-the-top outfits along the way.

These are all things we can look forward to before the bracket even comes cut. Sourch with the

Mac McClung, who has been a slam dunk viral sensation for nearty a decade starting in high school, etched his name in NBA All-Star Weekend history book in MBA All-Star Weekend history book with his second consecutive slam dunk contest title.

McClung, a G League player for the Osceola Magic with just four career NBA

Osceola Magic with just four career NBA games played, jumped over TNT analyst, Basketball of Hall of Famer and 7-footer Shaquille O'Neal, who was wearing a jersey from McClung's high school, Gate City in southwest Virginia, for a two-handed remarked.

school, Gate City in Southwest Virginia, for a two-handed reverse dunk.

McClung received a perfect score of 50 from judges Gary Payton, Fred Jones, Mitch Richmond, Darnell Hillman, Dominique Wilkins and slipped by Boston's Jaylen Brown for the champion-

ship.
"I'm trying to sit with it right now and what's "Tm trying to sit with it right now and take a second and understand what's going on," McClung said. "Ifeel like life is so fast sometimes, it's just I'll look back in 20 years when I cam't jump anymore and not as quick. But I know I'm a lucky dude.

"Shag is so cool to put on my high school jersey. Makes me emotional that he did that."

McClung needed a strong final dunk after Brown put on an oversize white glove on his left hand, jumped over Do-novan Mitchell and dunked with his left.

"I think ultimately in this media era, some players are afraid to make it into a meme or anything like that," Brown

said. "Like I wanted to come out and have fun with it, and that's what I did." McClung won \$105,000, which is almost more than he will make in the

G-League this season




